



Programmes based at the **QEII Community Centre**

Aboriginal Family Worker

Primary focus on assisting new parents and families with children aged 0 – 8 years, in a culturally appropriate way.

Muswellbrook Neighbourhood Service

Providing information, referral, advocacy and support. Muswellbrook Neighbourhood Service provides emergency relief such as food and electricity vouchers: needle and syringe exchange; community development function and school holiday projects.

Upper Hunter Family Support Service

Assisting families who may be experiencing difficulties. A service with a focus on strengthening and supporting families who have children in their care aged 0 to 12 years. Support may include, but not limited to: court support, referrals, parenting and financial education.

Our group worker can offer parenting support and information in a friendly group environment. These courses are offered at various locations throughout the Upper Hunter Region and topics include 1-2-3 Magic and Emotion Coaching, Triple P Seminar and Group and Engaging Adolescents.

Our Generalist Counsellor works with young people and adults experiencing a wide range of issues such as breakdown, self esteem, stress and work and family issues.

Upper Hunter Youth Development Officer

The Youth Development Officer provides support to existing youth services and has a role in identifying the needs of the youth sector and developing appropriate strategies.
